All applications must be completely filled out to receive approval. This is a rain or shine event, and as such, there will be **NO REFUNDS**. Applications will not be accepted after April 30, 2016. EQUIPMENT. All exhibitors/vendors are required to have a <u>secure</u> tent and are responsible for bringing or renting their own tent, tables, and chairs. Tents must be staked to the ground or weighted down. Stakes must not be in the walkways. Exhibitors/Vendors shall observe and abide by regulations made by Flat Rock, Our Hometown and the City of Flat Rock for efficient or safe operation of the event.

DISPLAY DIMENSIONS & REGULATIONS. Absolutely all displays, inventory, boxes, product, etc. must be contained within your booth space or assigned area. Distribution of samples and literature is strictly limited to the confines of the booth area.

INSURANCE. Exhibitors/vendors are responsible for their own property and for furnishing their own tents. Flat Rock, Our Hometown and the City of Flat Rock will not be responsible for damage to property or displays.

SIGNS. All signs must be professionally made or appear professionally made. Handwritten signs are not permitted. **HOURS OF OPERATION**. Exhibitors/vendors agree to staff their booth during all hours that the event is in progress. Event hours are from **10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 21, 2016.**

HEALTH DEPT. Any exhibitor giving away or selling food in their booth is responsible for all health permits, rules regulations, etc. Exhibitors are responsible for meeting all city/state resale licensing requirements.

CONDUCT AND CHARACTER. Exhibitors agree to conduct themselves in a respectful, cooperative manner. Any behavior deemed inappropriate by Flat Rock, Our Hometown or the City of Flat Rock may result in expulsion.
